GENERAL INFORMATION

This certification validates a person's entry-level skills with regard to planning, designing, building and maintaining digital media using Adobe Dreamweaver. The website includes learning objectives that will give you an idea of what to expect on the exam.

The certification exams are developed and administered by Certiport. See below for more detail about the exam and to access the link for Certiport.

TEST PREP

Adobe offers study guides for the exam. There is one for CS3 and one for CS4, and they include approximately 60 pages of exam objectives and step-by-step instructions for specific skills on the exam. You can download a copy of the packet on the webpage using the link given above. There are also test prep courses available. Training Options of Ft. Myers <http://www.trainingoptions.com/graphic-design-courses.html> and Future Media Concepts in Orlando <http://www.fmctraining.com/fmc.asp?l=Orlando> are two vendors that offer Adobe training. Future Media offers courses that run 2- 3 days in a classroom setting and on-line courses as well. The cost of a 2-3 day course is generally \$1,000-1,500. They offer a 10% discount to educators. Both companies will do on-site training for groups if preferred. The cost for an on-line course through the Adobe site ranges from \$50-\$150.

TAKING THE EXAM
