GENERAL INFORMATION

The Adobe website will not take you directly to the Flash MX Developer information. The links below should get you the information that you need. The Macromedia Flash MX 2004 Developer certification demonstrates an individual's competency as a Flash developer. The recommended background for a person who wishes to become certified in Macromedia Flash MX is:

- One to two years of object-oriented software development and/or scripting experience
- One to two years of involvement in web design, production, and graphics creation
- One to two years experience with **Macromedia Flash MX** or later
- Six months to one year of HTML and JavaScript
- Six months experience with database interaction using **Macromedia Flash MX** or later
- Six months experience with server architecture and/or streaming technologies with **Macromedia Flash MX 2004**

To become certified, you must pass an exam that includes 65 multiple-choice and true/false questions. You have 75 minutes to take the exam in a proctored test environment. A score of 70% is required to pass.
