



## Autodesk Certified Associate - Inventor

**Key Information:** 2009-10 Workforce Florida, Inc. Technical Skill Attainment list. Certification is on the CAPE funding list for 2009-10. The DOE certification code is ADESK019.

### GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

The exam relates to the Autodesk Inventor software. This 60 minute exam tests the knowledge and skills required to meet the exam objectives listed in the Exam Guide. The exam includes thirty multiple choice, point and click, and matching questions. A score of 77% is required to pass. **Note:** There are two certification options available for Autodesk Inventor: Inventor 2010 Certified Associate and Inventor 2010 Certified Professional. If you want to go a step further and earn the credential of Inventor Certified Professional, you must also pass the Inventor Certified Associate exam. You can pass the exams in any order, but to achieve the professional certification, both exams must be passed. The exam for Professional certification is 90 minutes long and an 80% is required to pass.

### TEST PREP

For the 2010 Certified Associate exam, Autodesk recommends **the** course “Learning Autodesk Inventor 2010” (or the equivalent) plus 100 hours of hands-on application time. (In the event that you are interested in the 2010 Certified Professional exam, Autodesk recommends the same course or equivalent plus 400 hours of hands-on application time.)

### TAKING THE EXAM

The cost of the Inventor 2010 Certified Associate exam is \$75. (The Inventor 2010 Certified Professional exam is \$125.) To find a test center and register for a certification exam visit:

#### Re-certification from Inventor 2009 Certified Professional

If you are an Autodesk Inventor 2009 Certified Professional you can update your certification to Autodesk Inventor 2010 Certified Professional by passing the Autodesk Revit Architecture 2010 Certified Associate exam as illustrated above. This applies only to re-certification from 2009 to 2010. If you are certified on an earlier release, you will have to take both the Certified Associate and Certified Professional exams to earn 2010 Certified Professional certification.
