### GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

The exam validates mastery of the fundamental knowledge and skills required to work in an Internet technology-enabled environment. Content covers basic knowledge of Internet technologies such as Web browsers, FTP and e-mail; Web page authoring using Extensible Hypertext Markup Language (XHTML); basic infrastructure networking, and project management. To become a CIW Associate the candidate must pass the *Site Development Foundations* module exam and complete the CIW Certification Agreement by logging in at

For the *Site Development Foundations* exam candidates must correctly answer at least 19 of the 30 multiple choice questions within the allotted time of 30 minutes to achieve a total score of 63% or greater in order to achieve a passing score .
