### GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

The certification is designed to provide a means for demonstrating competency in using Chief Architect software. The exam can be taken by Professional Designers, Academic Instructors, and Students.

The User Certification Exam is a four-hour exam. It covers actual use of the program and fill-in-the-blank questions. The exam is valid for the current version of Chief Architect and users re-certify for new versions of Chief Architect by taking that version's certification exam.

The three levels of certification are:

1. Certified Professional – Requires a high score on the comprehensive examination
2. Certified User – Requires a minimum score on the comprehensive examination
3. Certified Apprentice – (for Students & Academics) Requires a minimum score on a subset of the examination
