### GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

The CEA-CompTIA DHTI+ certification is an international, vendor-neutral certification that tests a technician's ability to configure, integrate, maintain, troubleshoot, and comprehend the basic design concepts of electronic and digital home systems. The exam consists of 97 questions and is 90 minutes long. A score of 680 on a scale of 100-900 is considered a passing score.
