GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

The NCCTs, or National Construction Career Tests, are a set of standardized achievement tests based upon industry skill standards. These tests measure the knowledge and skills of students prior to enrolling or after completing construction-related training.

The exam is a two-hour, 88 question closed-book examination with a cut score of 68%. It can be done on-line or as a paper/pencil test. All NCCER assessments are referenced to Contren® Learning Series modules. (You may order modules from Pearson (800.922.0579) or from NCCER's Online Catalog at www.nccer.org). The cost is \$24.00 for each paper/pencil exam and \$22.00 for a computer-based exam. If the exam is taken on-line the results are returned in just a matter of a couple of minutes. If the test is taken with paper and pencil, test results can be faxed in about 30 minutes.
