GENERAL INFORMATION

You must be an NCCER craft/technician instructor to have authorization to teach Contren[®] construction, maintenance, and pipeline curricula. All NCCER Craft/Technician Instructors must successfully complete the Instructor Certification Training Program (ICTP) for craft/technician instructors conducted by a NCCER Master Trainer. To get certified you must:

- Be approved by an NCCER Accredited Sponsor
 - Have experience at a minimum journey level or technician level in your area of expertise,
- OR**
- Have a minimum of three years experience as a certified teacher in a vocational/technical construction, maintenance, or pipeline-related training program. (The requirements will be verified by the accredited sponsor.)

To maintain your certification you must:

- Be endorsed or employed by an accredited training sponsor
- AND**
- Teach at least one of NCCER's standardized Contren[®] construction, maintenance, or pipeline modules for an accredited training sponsor once every two years,
- OR**
- Must re-attend the Instructor Certification Training Program (ICTP)
