GENERAL EXAM INFORMATION

ProStart is the two-year career-building program for high school students. At the end of the program, ProStart graduates possess a solid foundation for their future careers, and they receive the [ProStart National Certificate of Achievement](#). This certificate recognizes students who have successfully completed the program and are eligible to earn special scholarships and college credit from colleges and universities across the country. It also opens the door to our vibrant and growing industry.

TEST PREP

In order to earn this Certificate, students must pass National Restaurant Association Solutions' Year 1 and Year 2 exams, and complete 400 hours of mentored work experience. The exam answer sheets must be sent to the National Restaurant Association contact. Work hours are validated by a payroll stub or official timesheet. Employers must sign off on student skills and instructors validate hours worked. Both forms are sent to the National Restaurant contact.
